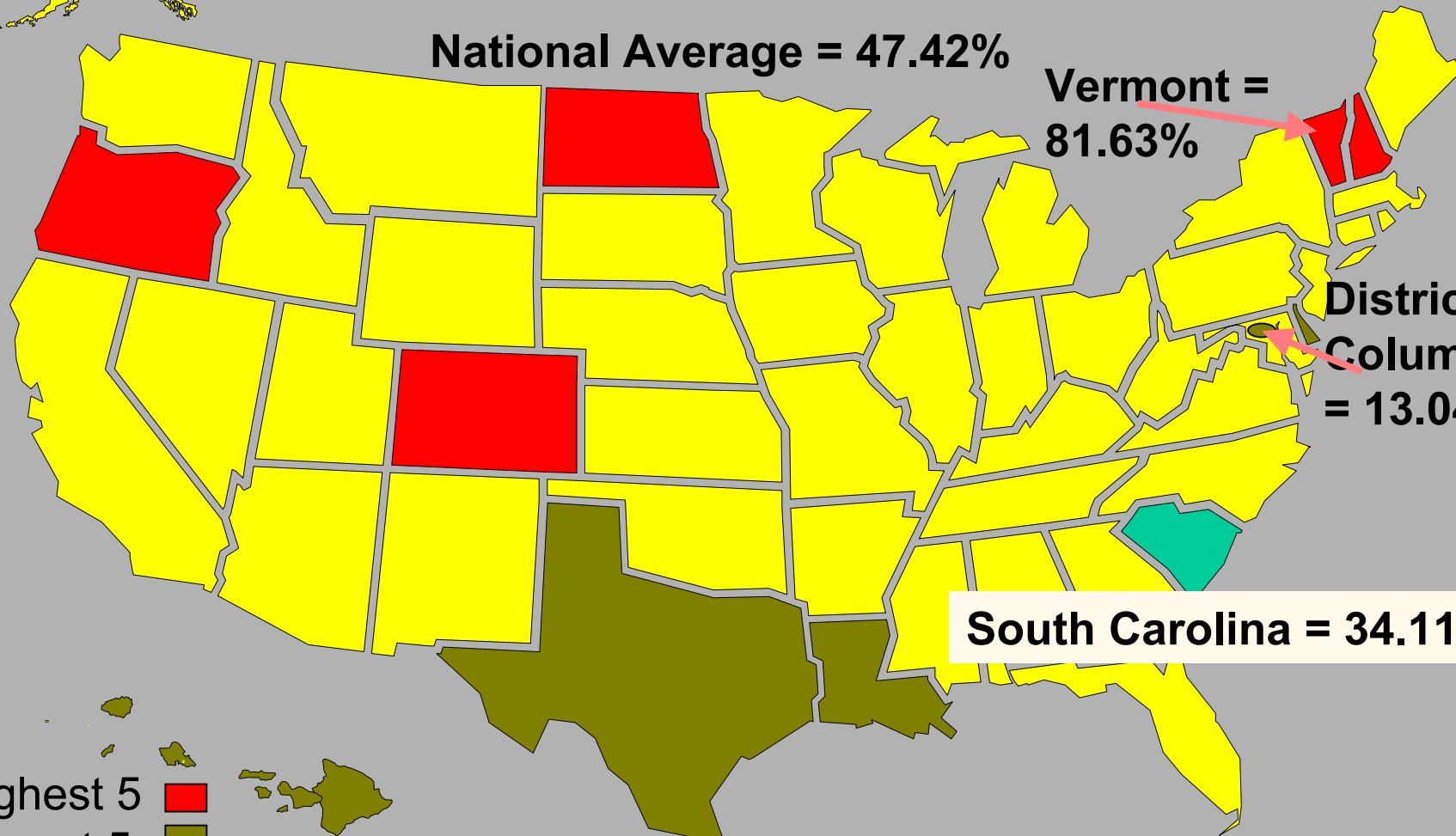
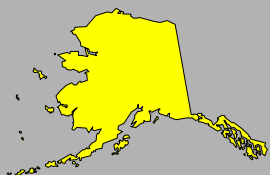

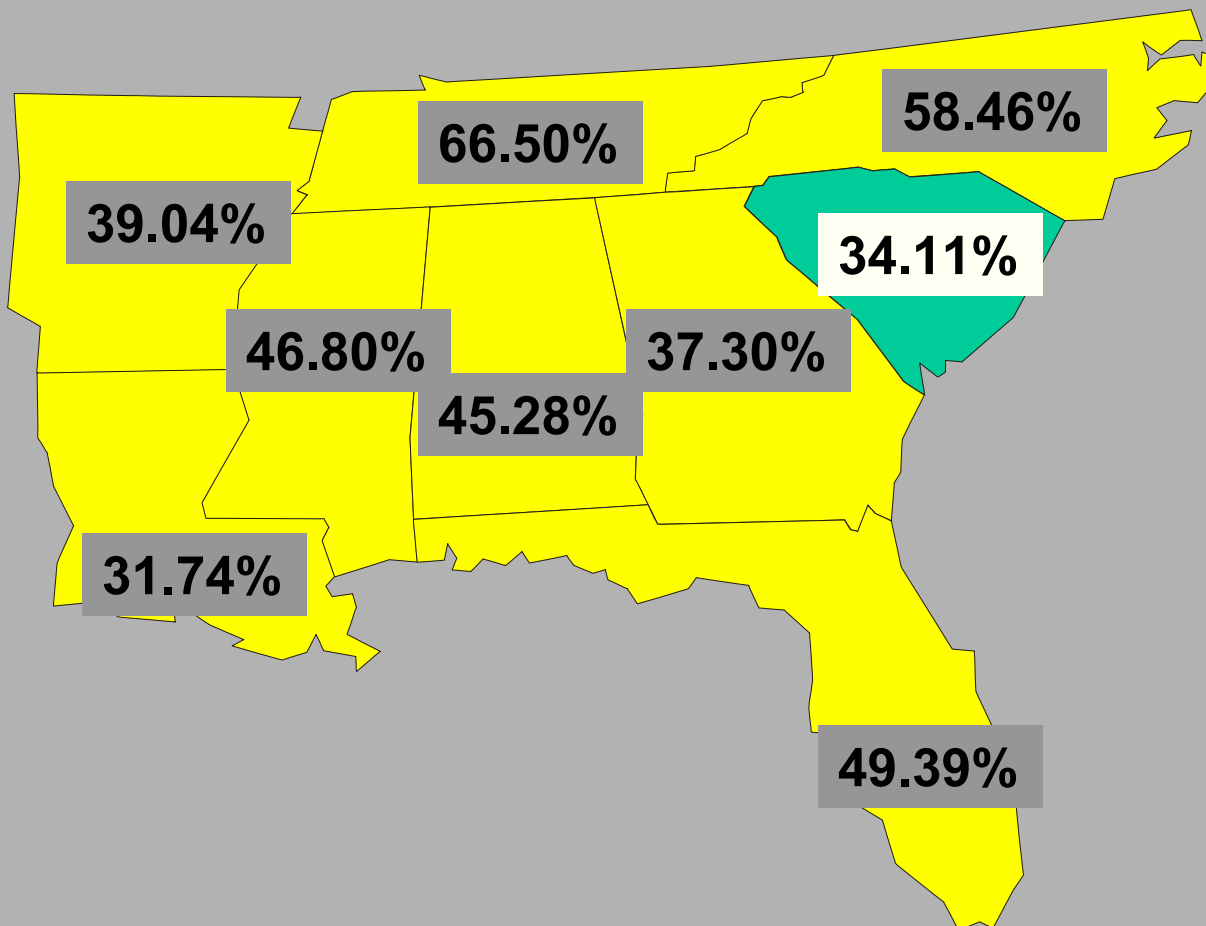


# Percent of Students with Disabilities in General Education (80% or more) - 1998-99

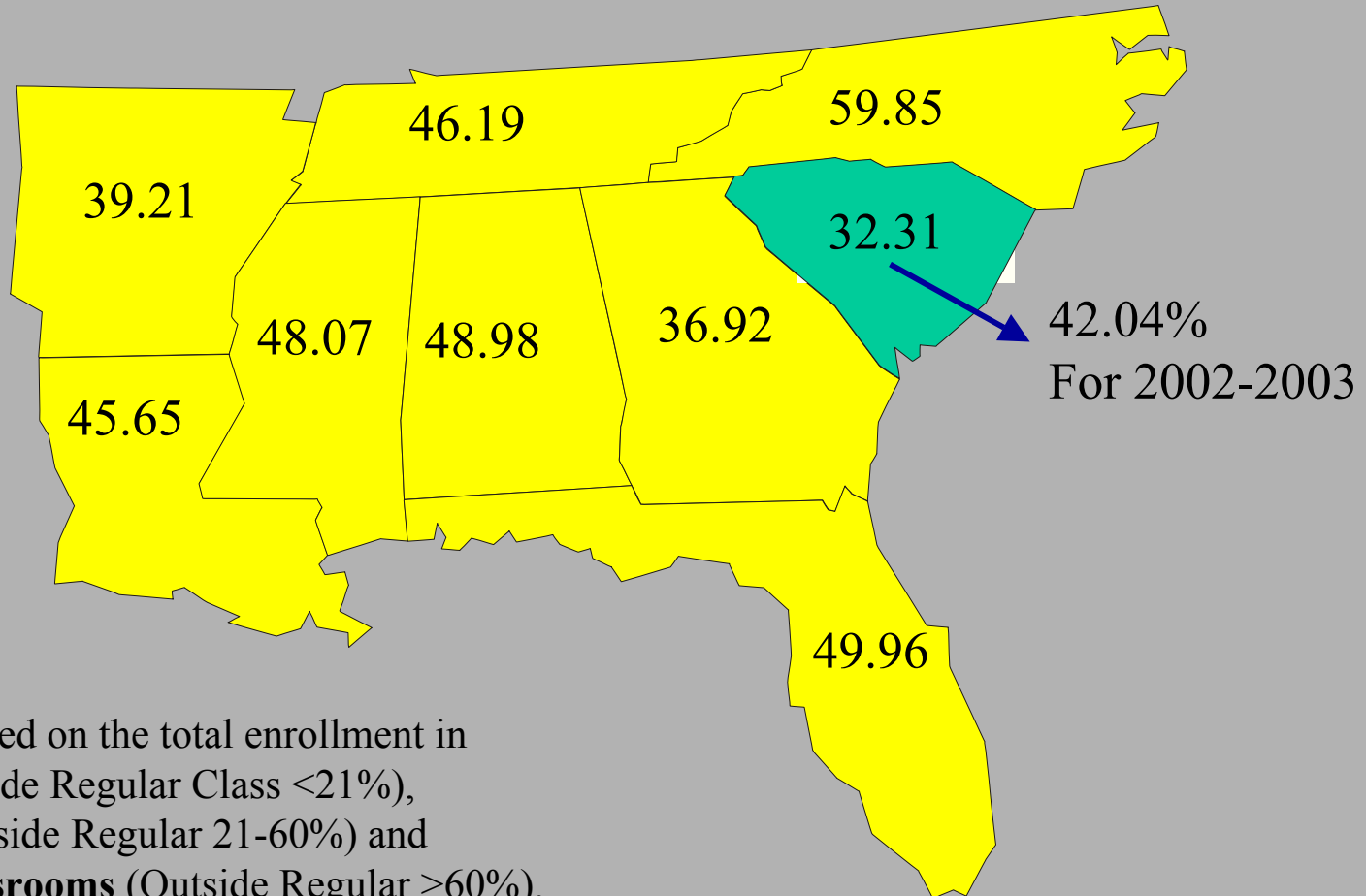

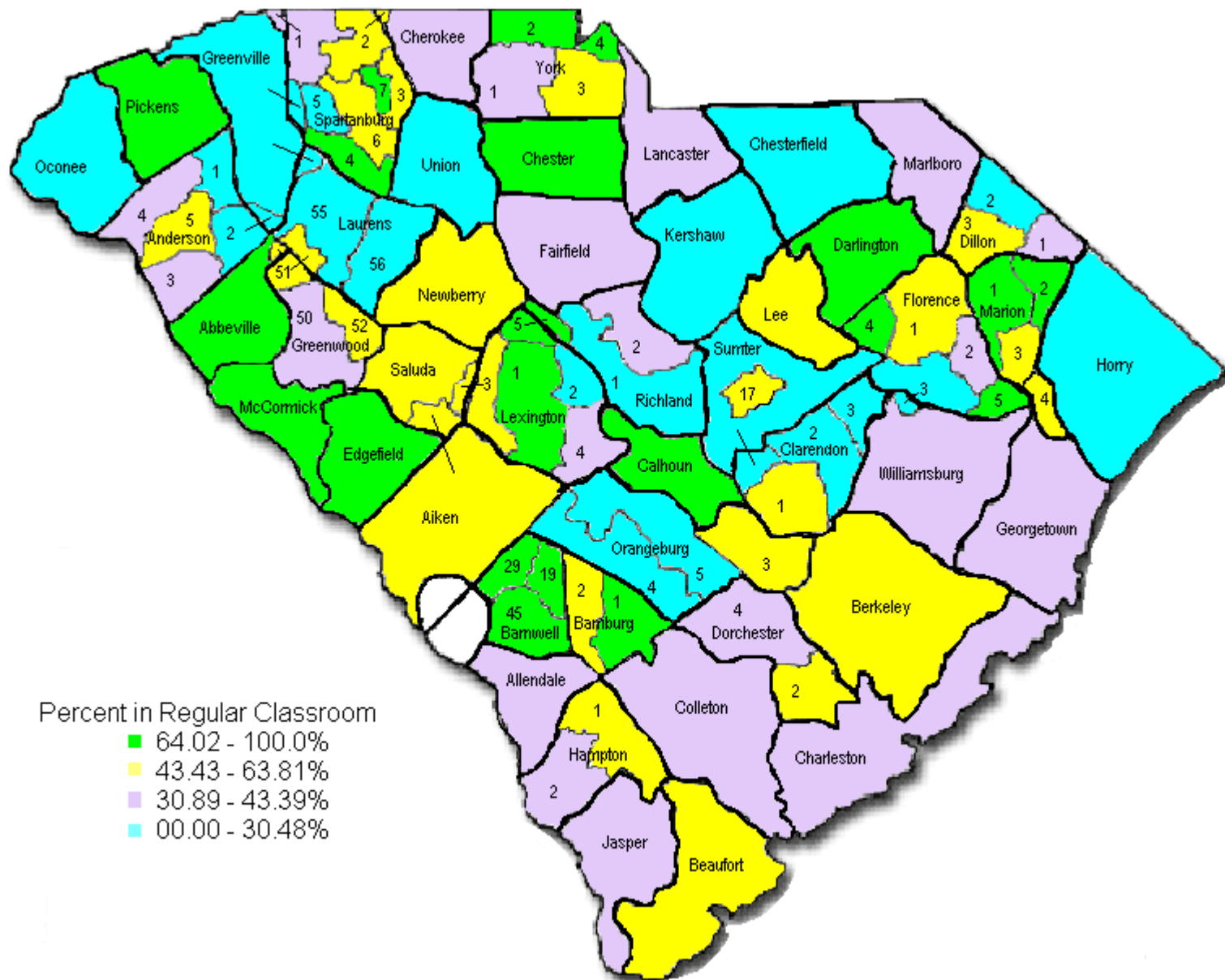
# Percent\* of Students 6-21 with Disabilities in General Education (80% or more) 2000-2001
